ABRIEFACHIEVEMENT (2016-20167)

1. APRIL 2016 :

CLEANLINESS DRIVE : Cleanliness drive was organized on the 7th April, 2016. About 60 volunteers and some devoted Staffsof the college were involved in the success of the work. The campus, especiallythe class rooms, office, toilets were cleaned and refreshment were given from the NSS fund.

2. JUNE 2016 : To Mark Green Mizoram Day on the 13th June, 2016 Govt. Saitual College NSS Unit Planted 200 saplings on the road side fromSaitual to Saichal ,two Km from Saitual PWD junction.

3. JULY 2016 : Social work was organized on the 28th July, 2016 for cleaning of the College Campus. College Office, Teacher's Common Room, Class Room, Library Room, Basket Ball Court, Tennis Court, Indoor Stadium, Boys and Girls Hostel were cleaned during this occasion.

4. AUGUST 2016 :

- (a) On 12th Aug. 2016 Swachhta Campaign Programme was organized in the College Jubilee Hall. Principal of Govt. Saitual College gave a lecture on the aim and objective of Swachhta Programme, which was very motivating.
- (b) Quiz Competition was organized on freedom struggle to mark the 70th Independence Day of India. The programme was chaired by Dr. Paul Songhaulal Songate, P.O, NSS and Quiz was hosted by Vanrammawii, Assistant Prof. History Deptt.
- (c) One Programme Officer and 10 volunteers attended Digital Quiz India Workshop on the 24th Aug. 2016 at the University Auditorium, MZU, Tanhril, Aizawl.

5. SEPTEMBER 2016 :

- (a) Social work was organized on the 17th Sept. 2016 where cleaning of College building and its surrounding was carried out.
- (b) On the 28th Sept. 2016 : Blood Donation Camp was organized in collaboration with Aizawl Civil Hospital, Blood Bank. About 113 Units (35 female and 88 male) of blood were donated.

6. OCTOBER 2016 :

- (a) On the 5th Oct. 2016 : Cleanliness drive was organized in the college campus. The college main building, office, class room, doors, windows and surrounding areas were cleaned and beautified.
- (b) 31st Oct. 2016 : Unity India Programme was organized in the College Jubilee Hall. The three P.Os gave a speech on the theme of Unity in India.

7. NOVEMBER 2016 : Pre- survey of adopted village was organized on the 4th November, 2016 for Special Camping in Thanglailung and Dilkhan villages. The three P.Os. and 5 volunteers visited the area and met the Village Council members.

8. JANUARY 2017 : Cleanliness Drive organized in the College main building on the 20th January 2017. The three Units participated in this cleanliness drive.

9. MARCH 2017 : Cleaning and clearing of plantation was organized on the 2nd March, 2017 at Saitual to Saichal road. 30 volunteers and three Programme Officers carried out the work.

10. MARCH 2017 : The NSS volunteers attended Disaster Management Workshop on the 17th March, 2017 at Chawnpui Veng Auditorium, Saitual Hmarveng, which was organized by the Village Council and the Assam Rifle.

SPECIAL CAMPING : During the Academic Session of 2016-2017, the NSS unit successfully organized three Special Camping in three villages - Thanglailung Village, Dilkhan Village and Saitual Chhimveng Village.

1. Thanglailung Village : Saitual Chhimveng Village which is a part of our adopted village, On the 2nd - 8th March 2017 , Unit III with the concerned Programme Officer organized Special Camping in Thanglailung Village. Awareness Campaign on the new theme, “Health, Public Sanitation and Personal Sanitation and Personal Hygiene” and Cleanliness Drive were organized during the camping. Cleaning of streets, bazar area, public places, drainages, etc. were undertaken. The NSS volunteers with the help of Village Council and NSS volunteers renovated Waiting Shed which was constructed during the year 2005.

2. Dilkhan Village : During 10th -16th March 2017, Unit II organized Special Camping at Dilkhan Village. On the first day, 10th March, 2017 orientation programme was organized in which the aims and objectives of NSS were studied. Some local volunteers and staff of the College participated in this camping. The volunteers also sensitized the public on the importance of cleanliness and hygienic living apart from the theme and campaign. The volunteers renovated Public Water Point during this camping. The Volunteers also taught the importance of cleanliness, health, sanitation and personal hygiene to the villagers.

3. Saitual Chhimveng Village: Unit I of the NSS Govt. Saitual College organized Special Camping on 22nd to 28th March, 2017. Some staffs of the institution and local volunteers accompanied this camping. During this camping awareness campaign and cleanliness drive was organized in public places. Extension of public water storage was the main work performed during this camping. Some local volunteers participated for the success of the programme.
