

**Students engagement in study tours and field trips for ensuring effective delivery of the curriculum**

**1. Brief Report of Study tour by Mizo Department (1<sup>st</sup> March, 2023)**

On 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2023, we visited Government Khawzawl College wherein interactions and short lectures took place and after a while, we started our journey towards “Chawngtlai” village which was 10kms from Government Khawzawl College. Speaking of Chawngtlai Village reminded of us Nikuala a warrior and a king from the village. He was immensely brave and had even shot two elephants, more than 200 animals from the forests and even fought with lions. His heroic deeds were even mentioned in our course materials and it was indeed an enthralling experience for us to visit his village. Besides, in Chawngtlai there were many historical places of our ancestors and below are some of the areas we have visited-

- Lungdawh – It is an important place in Mizo history, wherein our ancestors would use it as a waiting place in the past before they set out for hunting and farming in the forests. It was a privilege for us to witness this place, having to really see what has been taught in the class room was truly a great experience.
- Nikuala Inthawina Tlâng – It was a meditation mountain by the great warrior Nikuala of the village. From the view, on a clear sunny day we could see around 40 villages. The experience was truly refreshing.
- Sahlam- From Mizo folktales and folklores, we have often read the name Sahlam. In the past, warriors would hang the heads of the enemies they have killed there. Nikuala had even hung 20 heads in his time.

Besides, we have also visited places like Hrânglung, Lungsen Âien, Pasaltha Hrânghleia Thlan. We were very fortunate to witness all these historical places and we hold heartfelt gratitude to our teachers for taking the trouble in organising this study tour.

## 2. Brief Report of Study tour by Mizo Department, (18<sup>th</sup> - 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2023)

A study tour for visiting mizo historical places at Vangchhia, Vaphai, Farkawn, Dungtlang, Khawbung, Zawlsei, Samthang, Champhai, Zokhawthar and Tiau was organised by the Department of Mizo, Govt. Saitual College during the period 18<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> April, 2023. The tour begun at 6:30AM from Saitual and halted at Champhai for breakfast and we started our visits at Mangkhaia Lungphun & Chhura Fa Rep at Champhai which are all historical places. By 3:30PM - 4:30Pm we visited Lungphun, Kawtchhuah Ropui, Thlangtlak Mual, Laituma puk in historical village of Vangchhia. And by 5:30 PM we made it to Dungtlang and rest at Lianchhiari Lunglen Tlâng. On the second day of the tour that was 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 we visited places mentioned below-



1. Lianchhiari Lunglen tlang, Lianchhiari Puantahna, Dungtlang khaw hmun hlui
2. Hla Kungpui Mual at Khawbung
3. Selesih Sangsarih Lungphun at Zawlsei
4. Ṭhasiama Se no neihna tlang
5. Farkawn - Fiara tui, Lamsiâl puk, Kungawrhi hnuhluhna, Lamṭhuam thum, Chhura Chi rawt lung, Lungphaw Keiṭial, Fâr puk and Lianchea Ralven buk.

We ended the day by resting at Vaphai Zawlbuk. On the third day that was 20<sup>th</sup> April, we visited Fiara Tui, Ṭan tlang. Then, Ṭiau river and even crossed the border land between India & Myanmar. Finally, we ended the day by visiting Samthang Zopui phul hmun. On 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 that was the last day of our tour we made a visit to Lallula Zopui hmun hlui at Samthang. From then onwards we headed back to Champhai and then on the next day that was 22<sup>nd</sup> April, we finally made our way back to our starting destination, Saitual.

The five days study tour organised by the department of Mizo bought an immense experience for the students and we were very fortunate to make visits to several historical places mentioned in our curriculum. We believed that this type of study tour will have deep impact as well as enrichment to our learning processes.

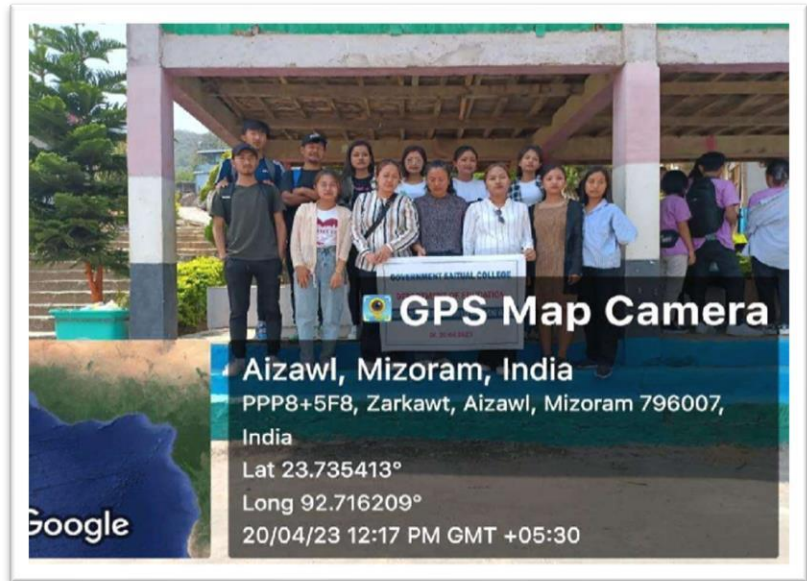

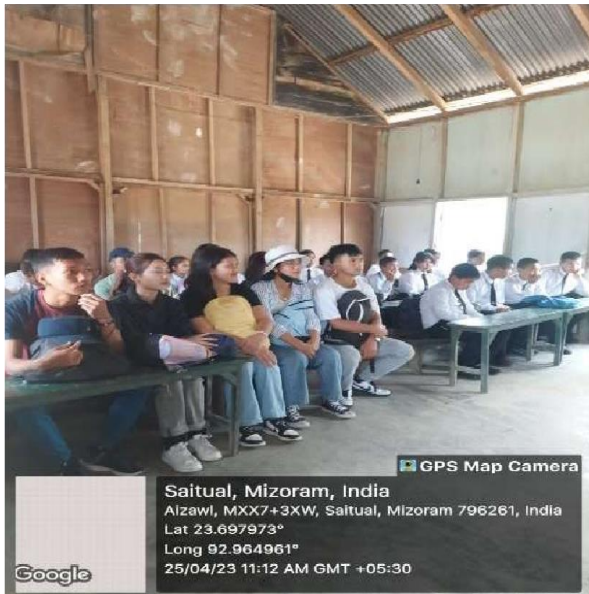
- Financial problems

### 4. Brief Report of Department of English Field trip to adopted village 'Mualphêng Village'

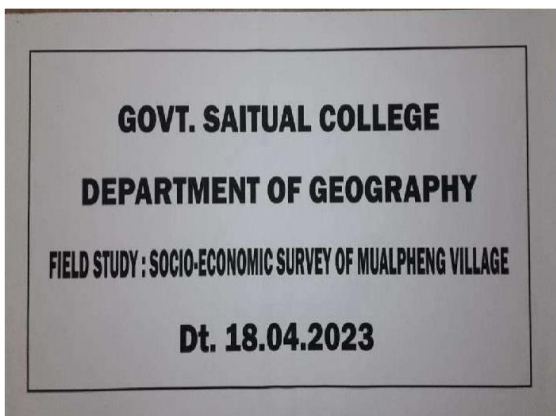
