TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR "SAFETY AND PRESERVATION OF TAMDIL LAKE"

1. INTRODUCTION:

Tamdil Wetland proves to be playing a very important part in maintaining the ecological balance in the environment. It harbor several plant and animal species and help in their prevention from extinction. It is also useful for human beings and serves as a great source for recycling organic waste. Given the importance of wetlands, it has become important for us to look into various issues involved in wetland conservation and suggest measures to protect them.

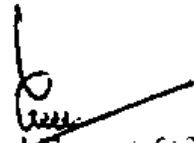
The conservation of Tamdil wetland needs management of environmental needs with a holistic approach. There should be people's participation and developmental activities should consider the immediate stress on the biota and the local community residing there. Legal instruments will not merely help in serving the purpose rather we need to involve all the stakeholders to conserve such ecosystems. The management programs should include sustainable measures so that those who are dependent on it do not suffer and biodiversity is protected. There is a need to adopt scientific, technical, and socio-economic cooperation to conserve the wetlands. Integrated management with a collaborative approach can pave the way for attaining the goal.

2. SCOPE OF WORK/TASKS:

- i) Conducting survey and necessary study for the preservation and safety of the areas.
- ii) Seek participation in preservation activity of the forest as necessary.
- iii) Providing guidance and awareness to a lower institution and to the local residents.
- iv) Plan and monitor the preservation programme of the Department as necessary.
- v) Conducting cleanliness activities.
- vi) Keeping the area for plastic free environment.
- vii) Planting of trees and look after them.
- viii) Giving suggestions to the Department for any necessary action.
- ix) Providing single emergency response to the areas for emergency response.
- x) Identification of location of the area which needs to be treated with necessary action.
- xi) Providing manpower as necessary.

RESOURCES PROVIDED:

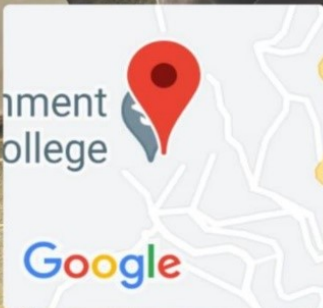
- i) The Department will hold the responsibilities for the successful and time bound implementation of any required action of the State Government.
- ii) The Department agrees to discharge the responsibilities effectively by allocating the required manpower and resources and by taking appropriate policy and operational decisions in furtherance thereof.
- iii) Take up awareness campaign and seminars about national programme on this preservation policies to College faculties and staffs.
- iv) Provide support the College in monitoring the cleanliness activity and safety measurement.
- v) Provide policies and suggestions to the College for providing safety measurement and preservation of the environment.
- vi) The Department will support the College for providing refreshment to the students on any cleanliness activity conducted by the College.

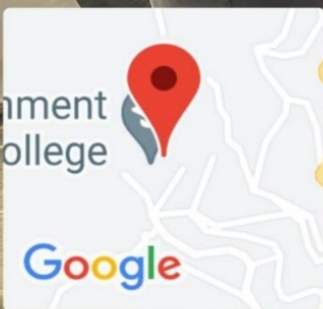
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
