A report on Graduation Day (18th July, 2025):

Govt. Saitual College celebrated its Graduation Day on 18th July, 2025, at GSC Auditorium for the 2024-2025 passed-out students. The event was grandly organised by the Teaching, Learning & Evaluation Cell, Govt. Saitual College. The special invitees of the programme were members of Joint Village Council (VC), Saitual District, President of Sihfa Village Council (VCP), Saitual District, and President of Alumni Association, GSC.

The programme was chaired by Mr. P. John. Tualzamang, Vice Principal, GSC, and the proceedings were guided smoothly by the comperes, Dr. Lalthangliana Junior (Asst. Prof. Dept. of English) and Ms. Liansangpuii Khiangte (Asst. Prof. Dept. of Pol.Sc)
